Always make sure to use the darker logo versions on lighter coloured backgrounds and the lighter logo versions on darker coloured backgrounds.










Page 06 Construction/Margins

To ensure the logo is always easily readable, a margin area defined by the width of the soft-cell shape is placed around the logo.


